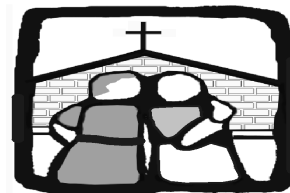

(Mark 8:22-26)

## INDIVIDUAL TOUCH

The healings, exorcisms, and miracles of Jesus were each performed in a unique manner. Different techniques and emphases. No predictable pattern. Sometimes he seemed to want publicity and sometimes privacy.

POINT: God creates, loves, teaches,  
and empowers every individual in a unique way. My answer does

## A SLOW STEADY MIRACLE

- spit / touch / quest
- “kinda sorta”
- touch / clarity
