

A ROOM and RULE

## **PLACE** ... symbolized the <u>uniqueness</u> of God

\* just one God/place

Procedure ... symbolized the unapproachableness of God \*individual > animal > priest > blood > GOD

Tabernacle and Temple ...
Sacrifices and Rituals
These formalities simply bought
time ... a temporary truce

## When Christ came ...

- a different tabernacle
- his <u>own</u> blood
- obtained <u>full</u> forgiveness
- our conscience cleansed
- we may <u>serve</u> God

Justice <u>DEMANDS</u> some form of acknowledgement of the wrong and payment for the wrong

## God cannot tilt toward intolerance or indulgence!

Therefore he offers <u>forgiveness</u>
AND he requires <u>blood</u>

Because the sacrifice of Christ was perfect, <u>once</u> was <u>sufficient</u>.

DEATH. Because we are COVERED and CLEANSED by Christ's blood, we do not <u>fear</u> the <u>judgement</u> following <u>death</u>.
