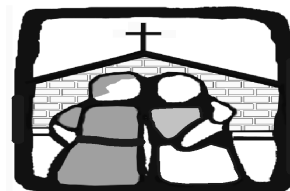

As you are aware, OUB is set up administratively with Committees and Commissions which fill various needs of church life and ministry. Our system uses rotation which places individuals on a committee for 2 or 3 years, then as they are finished someone else is appointed for a similar term. Amazingly, this system/shadow persisted (determined the course of life) from Adam till Christ. This shadow was heavy. The light was quite dim. No one knew how to make the light bright enough to see/find an escape. Spiritual life was heavy. This was B.C.
