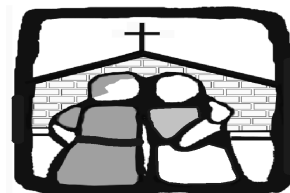

God has honored marriage (in many ways). If we refuse to do so, we express contempt for God’s plan. This applies to both casual _____ (*I Cor. 7:9*) and casual _____ (*Matt. 19:6*).

SEXUAL PURITY

God is _____ about sexual purity, a sin with many consequences (*I Cor. 6:18*). It often leads to broken marriages and homes which led to a _____ of anger, disillusionment, and desperation. God’s judgment is not always fire raining from the sky (*Gen 19*). It is embedded within the very fruits of disobedience and manifests in the _____ of the culture. When we break God’s law, eventually

God's law breaks us. We see this today in the rising tide of torment, abandonment, bitterness, and violence (in spite of increased psychological and humanitarian services!). For the married and unmarried, a commitment of sexual purity is the only way to honor marriage and receive God's best blessings (*Prov. 5:1-23*).
