

Without a RELATIONSHIP with God there can be neither the sustained **ability** or **desire** to live up to the Bible's standards of morality.

Information > Expectation > Motivation

(Hebrews 13:1) "Love the brothers..."

We are not told to "make it happen," but to "let it continue"

Relief! I do not have to manufacture love! Instead, I simply refuse to stifle or neglect [God's] love, but determine to nurture and express it.

"Therefore, since we have been justified through faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ through whom we have gained access by faith into this grace in which we now stand..."

God has poured out his love into our hearts by the Holy Spirit, whom he has given us. (Romans 5:1,5)

Get over preoccupation with self. Become preoccupied with others!

Be devoted to one another in brotherly love. Honor one another above yourselves!

(Romans 12:10)

Do nothing out of selfish ambition or vain conceit, but in humility consider others better than yourselves. Look not only to your own interests, but also to the interests of others.

IMPORTANCE OF "BROTHERLY LOVE"

- a) Reveals to the world that I belong to Christ (John 13:35)
- b) Adds assurance to my own identity/confidence as a Christian (1 John 3:14)
- c) Brings delight and glory to God (1 John 3:16, 4:11-12)

The <u>desire</u> to <u>help</u> the needy stranger must outweigh the <u>fear</u> of being <u>exploited</u>

(Hebrews 13:3)
"Love the prisoner/persecuted..."

We do not need to experience any particular situation in order to identify/sympathize with those who do.


So in everything, do to others what you would have them do to you. This sums up the Law and the Prophets.
