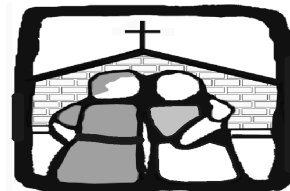

If you are following along with our 2021 Feast on the Word reading plan, this week (Mar. 1 – 6), we will be reading



- 1 – Deuteronomy 26-28; Mark. 12-14
- 2 – Deuteronomy 29-31; Mark 15-16; Psalm 22
- 3 – Deuteronomy 32-34; Hebrews 3; Psalm 1
- 4 – Catch up day (Optional); Psalm 19, 106
- 5 – Joshua 1-3; Acts 1-3
- 6 – Joshua 4-6; Acts 4-6

### HAPPY RELATIONSHIPS!

2. Do not \_\_\_\_\_ the \_\_\_\_\_ of others. Simply \_\_\_\_\_ to \_\_\_\_\_ your own situation (*Prov. 14:30, 24:19-20*)
3. Gossip and slander create \_\_\_\_\_, including the one who speaks it. (*Prov. 10:18, 11:12-13, 12:13*)

When Jesus said, "Love your neighbor," he knew that your neighbor would ACT, LOOK, and BELIEVE differently than you.

That's kinda the whole point!

4. When involved in a dispute, understand \_\_\_\_\_ motives before making a \_\_\_\_\_. (*Prov. 18:17, 26:17*)
5. Keep your life right \_\_\_\_\_ so that God can keep your neighbors right \_\_\_\_\_. (***Prov. 16:7, 25:21-22***)
