a refuge. *(14:26)*

Be **KIND**. This is a **seed** whose **harvest** will come back to benefit you.

A kind hearted woman gains respect,  
but ruthless men gain only wealth.  
A kind man benefits himself, but a cruel  
man brings trouble on himself. *(11:16-17)*

He who brings trouble on his family will  
inherit only wind... *(11:29)*

Be **careful** and **thoughtful** with words.

Reckless words pierce like a sword, but the tongue of the wise brings healing. *(12:18)*

Pleasant words are a honeycomb, sweet to the soul and healing to the bones. *(16:24)*



**PARENTS. Critical and essential  
that you establish discipline.**

He who spares the rod hates his son, but he who loves him is careful to discipline him.

*(13:24)*

Discipline your son, for in that there is hope. Do not be a willing party to his death. A hot tempered man must pay the penalty. If you rescue him, you will have to do it again.

*(19:18-19)*
