Vs. 21 – The Truth is in Jesus

Vs. 22 – You took off your former  
way of life

Vs. 23 – You are being renewed in  
the Spirit of your mind

Vs. 24 – You put on the new self



## This is how it works

Matthew 12:30 – Jesus says anyone who is not with me is against me ... There is no 3<sup>rd</sup> option. It is either **Christ** or **Chaos**, and a person's worldview will reflect that.



The word used for truth in Eph. 4 is “aletheia”, this word translates to truth or **reality**.



Same word as in Romans 1:18-19  
where it says people by their  
unrighteousness **suppress** the  
**aletheia** (truth or reality).



So those without a Biblical worldview will never be **consistent**, they will **constantly** live in the **chaos** of their worldview and never be able to maintain what reality is without borrowing from God's point of view.



# What do we do ?

God's word is our guide: **READ IT**

Psalms 119:105 - Your word is a  
lamp for my feet, a light on my path.



Do/Do not **answer the fool**

Proverbs 26:4-5 - Do not answer a fool according to his folly, or you yourself will be just like him. Answer a fool according to his folly, or he will be wise in his own eyes.



# **Speak like the prophets spoke**

I John 2:15-17 - Do not love the world or anything in the world. If anyone loves the world, love for the Father is not in them. For everything in the world the lust of the flesh, the lust of the eyes, and the pride of life comes not from the Father but from the world. The world and its desires pass away, but whoever does the will of God lives forever.
