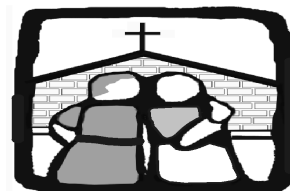

## "What if some do not believe...?"

(Romans 3:3)

In our world today, there are many believers... and MANY unbelievers.

In our country today, the population percentage of unbelievers is growing.

### Why Do Beliefs Change or Die Away?

† New \_\_\_\_\_ (information change). \*Old belief proven \_\_\_\_\_

† New \_\_\_\_\_ (circumstances change) \*Old belief becomes  
\_\_\_\_\_

New FACTS about God?

The Bible?

New REALITIES that changed perception of God?

a) \_\_\_\_\_ (self-sufficiency)

\*I do not \_\_\_\_\_ to trust God to supply my needs!

b) \_\_\_\_\_ (busyness)

\*I do not have \_\_\_\_\_ to trust God or contemplate whether I should!

c) \_\_\_\_\_ (science)

\*I do not \_\_\_\_\_ to trust God. I will measure/explain everything  
by my own "reason."

These (and other) realities compete with faith, worship, and devotion to God  
so that in practice many people do not \_\_\_\_\_ or \_\_\_\_\_ FAITH  
IN GOD.

**\*Does this change God's faithfulness (to us) OR the effectiveness  
of our faith in Him?**

a) **God** = \_\_\_\_\_ His character is untouched by popularity, doubt,  
or rebellion (vs. 4).

b) **Believer** = \_\_\_\_\_ Our salvation as individuals is unassailable  
and cannot be damaged by skepticism, criticism, or persecution (*Rom. 8:28-39*).  
God's promises are not given for popular appeal, but for personal response  
(*Rom. 1:16-17*).

God has promised to save any person who calls on his name with genuine faith in  
Christ (*Rom. 6:23, 10:5-13*). Even if every dictator, skeptic, rebel, and  
egomaniac of history screamed that it was not true, it would still be true!

## SO WHAT?

1. Don't be \_\_\_\_\_ by cultural \_\_\_\_\_! World views are many and contradictory. No matter what you believe, there are scores of skeptics.

So trust what the Bible says.

2. Don't be \_\_\_\_\_ by \_\_\_\_\_! In a world described as "The dominion of darkness" (*Col. 1:3*), why would we expect to be embraced? This world will someday pass away. Don't get caught up in its popularity. (*1 Jn. 2:15-17*).
