

In many respects, life is based on trust. We earn loyalty and we expect loyalty. Yet BETRAYAL happens in many areas of life and takes many forms. Betrayal is a serious matter and always exacts consequences.

NT word: "betray"

Give/submit to one, but also to another

JOHN 13

Example... serve one another (13-15)

Connection... God > Christ = Disciple > Seeker (19-20)

DISCONNECT... Some will _____ with me, but _____ with my enemy. (18, 21)

Response... ignorance/confusion (22-30)

BETRAYAL

JEHOVAH the Lord often expressed dismay and indignation at the people of Israel. As their Creator, Redeemer, and Provider the Lord had shown them great favor. Yet they made and worshiped _____ even while they acknowledged the Lord with their culture (*Jer. 2*). Eventually God's anger became a resolve to punish them without mercy (*Jer. 7*). He saw their _____ as betrayal (*Mt. 6:4*).

JESUS The very same crowd/citizenry of Jerusalem that _____ and acknowledged Christ (*Jn. 12:12-18*) soon _____ "Crucify him."
(*Jer. 19:12-16*)

JEALOUS GOD (Deuteronomy 6)

"Why should I fear and serve the Lord? • How can I maintain a singleness of purpose and a constant devotion to the Lord? • How can I resist temptation to move my allegiance and energy to worldly affairs? • What can motivate me to give priority to God alone? • How can I stay faithful to God till the day I die?

• I do not WANT to betray the Lord, but I am WEAK. What is my solution?
