(15:18)

Do not <u>envy</u> the <u>advantages</u> of others. Simply <u>work</u> to <u>improve</u> your own situation.

A heart at peace gives life to the body, but envy rots the bones.

(14:30)

Do not fret because of evil men or be envious of the wicked, for they have no future hope and their lamp will snuffed out.

(24:20)

Gossip and slander create <u>no</u> <u>winners</u>, including the speaker.

Whoever spreads slander is a fool. (10:18)

A man who lacks judgment derides his neighbor, but a man of understanding hold his tongue. A gossip betrays a confidence, but a trustworthy man keep a secret.

(11:12-13)

An evil man is trapped by his sinful talk, but a righteous man escapes trouble.

(12:13)

When involved in a dispute, understand <u>all</u> motives before making a <u>judgment</u>.

The first to present his case seems right, until another comes forward and questions him.

(18:17)

Like one who seizes a dog by the ears is a passerby who meddles in a quarrel not his own.

(26:17)

Keep your life right with God so that God can keep your neighbor's right with you.

When a man's ways are pleasing to the Lord, he makes even his enemies to live at peace with him. (16:7)

If your enemy is hungry, give him food to eat. If he is thirsty give him water to drink. In doing this you will heap burning coals on his head and the Lord will reward you.
