WHEN YOU HEAR THE MUSIC...

IMAGES/IDOLS

The Bible always describes idolatry as an insult/abomination to the Lord. It is grouped with magic sorcery, murder, and immorality (Gal. 5:19-21, Rev. 21:8, 22:15). Most often it refers to the
WHERE does such depravity come from? It is an insidious method of skirting God's
to live by (Hab. 2:4, 11 Cor. 5:7, etc.) by the invisible/ineffable with something to be seen and touched (Rom. 1:21-23). The
Revelation of John describes a dragon (Satan) who employs a beast to denounce God and deceive people. What does the beast do? He sets up an "image," something to which gullib stupid humans attach their loyalty (Rev. 13:11-17, 14:11, 15:2, 16:2, 19:20, 20:4).
God insists that "faith" us to him.
Idolaters insist that an "Image" God to us.
 I Samuel 15:23 attempt to alter the future or control persons (divination/witchcraft) REBELLION attempt to manipulate God into an "image (idolatry) ARROGANCE * Idol worship expresses defiance, contempt, and insubordination towards God's transcendence
Ultimately, anything that <u>outranks</u> or <u>replaces</u> God in my or interferes with
fellowship with God in my has become a substitute, and idol of my life.
This is
THE GOD IN THE MIRROR Today, we reject God's sovereignty and claim that we have all authority. We insist that "right/wrong" are defined and determined by ourselves. WE worship our OWN lives an agendas. So, as we idolize ourselves, we repeat the very sin of Adam and Eve who wished to "be like God" (Gen. 3:4).
This is visible today in the increasing and defiance of God's simple rules
(morals) for living <u>and</u> increasing towards God's day of judgment <u>and</u> the
increasingof acknowledgement of God in public settings or policy.
