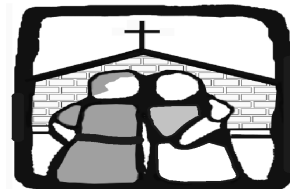

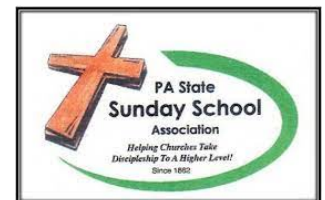

### Wrath > Absorbed [SHIFT]
