SEXUAL/GENDER STANDARDS

Our desire/quest for intimacy is most fully expressed/satisfied in sex. Although (physically)
sex provides for pleasure and procreation, its greatest provision is (emotional) partnership or
bonding. The intense bond that sex creates actually reflects the bond of Three Persons in One
Being [God]. In this sense, sex is sacred. Just as God is one [spirit], sexual partners become one
[flesh]
(Gen. 2:24, Mt. 19:4-6).
Sex is our most open, unguarded, vulnerable expression of SELF, therefore it offers the
strongest ties of connection and the greatest potential for relationship. Because of its psychological
and spiritual component, God expects us to sex
Scripture says it should not be awakened/aroused until the time is right because it causes partners
to "belong" to each other (S of S 8:4, 7:10), and it should be protected by a preceding commitment
[marriage] (1 Cor. 7:9).
TWO GENDERS How and Why?
a) One "side" of Adam was removed and given expression in a
i.e. male and female (Gen. 1:27, 2:21-22)
b) God differentiated/separated his image into two aspects so that the
fellowship/appreciation/wonder of his image could be experienced both
and (Can 2:22 25 5:2)
and (Gen. 2:23-25, 5:2)
Both male and female witnesses are essential to the representation of God.
c) This pattern is <u>repeated</u> with God's Son who is described as the "last Adam"
<i>(1 Cor. 15:45)</i> . We are "conformed into his image" <i>(Rom 8:29)</i> yet are
from him as his "bride" (Jn. 3:29). The word "church" in the New
Testament is always [linguistically] feminine (Eph. 5:25).
GENDER IDENTITY. We believe God has designed/assigned sexual

and the sex of birth should be and Those who struggle with
gender identity must recognize that suffering is common to fallen humanity and may be used
by God for his glory (11 Cor. 12:7-9). They should also recognize that a temptation to altar
their sexual identity is no different from other "temptations" common to man (1 Cor. 10:13).
HOMOSEXUALITY . Because God's pattern and instruction and created anatomy clearly
indicate only heterosexual expression, we believe that homosexuality is
and to God. Same sex attraction must be dealt with no differently
than other temptations (Rom. 1:18-32, 7:21, 8:17).
than other temptations (Norm. 1.10 32, 7.21, 0.17).
PORNOGRAPHY . We believe it is sinful to remove sex from the context of marriage and
make it explicit to others, using sex to create profit and arouse lust. Pornography makes
nudity and fornication seem (<i>Eph. 5:5-7</i>) and people to sin (<i>Mt. 5:27-30, Lk. 17:1-3</i>). It must be avoided and resisted (<i>11 Cor. 6:13, 18-20,</i>
Gal. 5:19-21).
