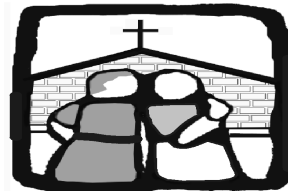

September 19 – *Marriage/Family Standards*

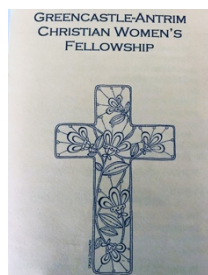
September 26 – *Social Standards*

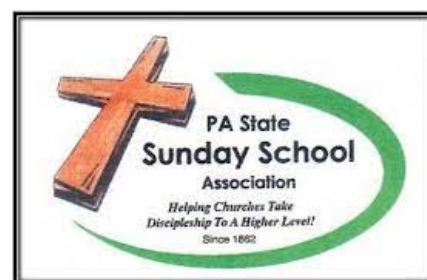

MARRIAGE/FAMILY STANDARDS

At the beginning, God created man/woman to be _____ or _____ (Gen. 2:18, 20). And “for this reason” (2:24) there is to be _____ that involves mind, will, and body (2:24-25). This type of connection necessarily involves _____ of all other bonds and priorities. This reality [marriage] is designed and ordained by God.

- _____, _____ (Mt. 19:3-12, 1 Cor. 7)
- earthly _____ of Christ/church (Eph. 5:22-33)
- impossible for God to honor _____ “marriage” (Mt. 19:4, Is. 62:2-5)

COHABITATION Since the Bible links sexual relations (Gen. 2:24, Heb. 13:4), child rearing (Mal. 2:13-15, Col 3:18-21) and the stability of society (Prov. 6:34, 12:4, 31:10-11, 23) with MARRIAGE, any _____ of marriage without its actual commitment is a circumvention of God’s plan. Cohabitation sends _____ and causes confusion (1 Cor. 14:33). We believe that cohabitation is sinful and insist that church members do not remain in this lifestyle.

ADULTERY is a grievous sin against God and spouse (Ex. 20:14, Mt. 15:19-20, 1 Cor. 6:9-11). It leaves only _____. (Prov. 6:26, 30:35). Although God permits divorce in this circumstance (Mt. 19:8), we believe that forgiveness and reconciliation are _____ for any wrong and strongly encourage humility, repentance, and restoration (Mt. 6:12, 19:6, Lk. 6:27-31, 17:3-4, Eph. 4:32, Col. 3:13-14).

SINGLENES An unmarried person (for any reason) bears the image of God and finds wholeness in Christ (Gal. 2:20). Scripture affirms that singleness has _____ (1 Cor. 7:1, 28) and is therefore God’s calling or best alternative for some individuals (Mt. 19:12, 1 Cor. 7:32-35). We believe God’s love and power are not diminished or differentiated between single or married (Gal. 3:26-29).

FAMILY Whatever the makeup or blend of our family, it honors and reflects God most when confusion, chaos, anger, resentment, etc. are not allowed to thrive. Insist on _____ and _____! Loving leadership (husband) and cooperative support (wife) and mutual submission/sacrifice (Eph. 5:21-33) is God’s _____ for all families. We believe parents should dedicate children to the Lord (Lk. 2:22-24) and train them in prayer, worship, Christian doctrine and discipleship (Eph. 6:1-2)
