

So the Lord God caused the Adam to fall into a deep sleep; and while he was sleeping, he took one of the Adam's ribs (OR part of the Adam's side) and closed up the flesh.

Because sex is <u>so much more</u> than physical, God expects us to <u>treat</u> sex <u>carefully</u>.

TWO GENDERS

- a) Whatever was separated from the man was given expression in a <u>different</u> <u>body</u> of its own!
- b) By dividing his image into different aspects, it could be experienced both **partially** and **fully**.
- c) This pattern is repeated with Jesus ("last Adam"). Though we are part of him, we are <u>differentiated</u> from him and referred to as his bride.



God has designed/assigned sexual **distinctiveness** and the sex of birth should be **honored** and **maintained**.



We believe...

Same gender sex is sinful and unacceptable to God. This is based on the pattern God infused into the created world (including the human anatomy) as well as the clear instructions and warning in both the Old and New Testaments.



Pornography implies that all sorts of sexual immorality is acceptable (normal or desirable or non-consequential) and causes people to sin. It mocks relationship, commitment, and marriage. It must be avoided and resisted.
