WHAT MATTERS MOST?

This JAMES, who wrote our NT letter was very probably the (earthly) brother of Jesus... son of Joseph and Mary (Mat. 13:55-56, Gal. 1:19)
*Why did James not highlight/leverage his famous connection to Jesus?

1. The letter was not about him this truth was not related to his earthly familial
connection; therefore, that issue was inappropriate. * "Good news" and "Right time" are different realities. On some occasions,
KNOWS THIS. (Prov. 27:14, Eccl. 3:1, 8)
*Any attempt to speak for someone else (even God) easily becomes tangled with personal emotions and ambition. Intermediaries have issues also! The only sure way not to interfere is to
2. The urge to write did not emerge from social or familial connections.
* Earthly connections were neither nor for
those who wrote the Bible. It was the compulsion to record the truth that God revealed to them. (11 Peter 1:16-21)
3. This family connection was insignificant COMPARED to the vital spiritual reality of "servant > LORD".
* "EARTHLY SIBLING OF JESUS" was no advantage to James
