THE RIGHTEOUS FOR THE UNRIGHTEOUS

WE NEED HELP because of the nature of sin's penalty!

- a **DEBT** I cannot **pay**
- a GUILT I cannot <u>escape</u>
- a **DEATH** I cannot **survive**

THE POWER OF A SUBSTITUTE

- Our ability to substitute for one another has no <u>limits</u>
- 2. A substitute must meet all **<u>qualifications</u>** and be able to withstand all <u>**conditions**</u>
- In the substitution of Christ for me ... The POWER of sin was <u>broken</u>.
- There is nothing left to be used <u>against me</u>.

OBLIGATION > PAIDLOAN: √life√love√provisionDEBT: √gratitude√allegiance√obedience

Jesus lived an earthly life of perfect allegiance and obedience to God!

Sin/Sinfulness creates an unpayable debt.

Jesus paid our debt not as a <u>loan</u> to us but as a <u>substitute</u> for us!

WEIGHT > REMOVED (guilt)

Present <u>victories</u> or future <u>intentions</u> do not erase past <u>failures</u>.

SUBSTITUTION. Because Christ <u>became</u> our sin, he bore the weight of its guilt. √My sin is no longer an issue with God! √I am released from God's condemnation!

WRATH > ABSORBED

The death sentence represents the ultimate **barrier** for substitution yet the ultimate **need** for substitution.

The physical death of Jesus illustrated the **spiritual separation** from God which he experienced.

For Christ died for our sins once for all, the righteous FOR [in place of] the unrighteous to bring you to God. *(I Peter 3:18)*
