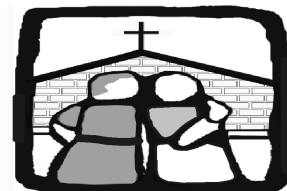

A BETTER WAY TO LIVE

- Carefully consider your _____ toward what you “want”
 - My pleasure only? (selfish) God’s glory? (unselfish)
- _____ for what you want (cf. 1:5-6)
 - Jesus admonished this technique based on God’s love for his children (Mt. 5:7-9). This does not exclude work, strategy, barter, purchase, etc. “Seek/Knock” indicates considerably more effort than simply “ask.”
- If what you want is contested by another, seek to find resolution in godly _____ or in _____ rather than fights and quarrels.”
