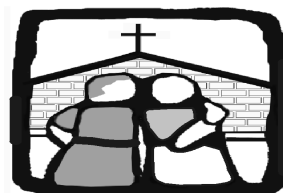

As you may know, Fairview Elementary School (Waynesboro) is expanding their playground and replacing old equipment as a way of honoring and continuing the legacy of Lori Akers. Lori taught Phys Ed at Fairview for 21 years and was very committed to using the outdoor playground to teach life skills. This expanded playground area will be called Akers 2 Play. The school is currently raising funds (goal = \$100,000) and will honor donors with a plaque by the entryway arch. Knowing the love for Lori within the OUB family, we feel that a plaque listing the church as a donor would be very appropriate for this effort. So, during June there will be specially marked ENVELOPES on the Narthex table where the offering receptacles currently are. If you wish to give towards this playground project, please use these envelopes and put them in the regular offering containers. Make checks out to OUB. We will not use money given to any OUB ministry for this, and we are not seeking to purchase any particular piece of equipment. And, of course, if you wish to have your own donation put on a plaque, you may give to the school independently of this. This is simply a way for you to participate in honoring Lori in the name of this church, which she greatly loved.
