PATIENCE ... product of <u>faith</u> and expression of <u>mercy</u>

When disputing is necessary, express it in the most **positive** way **possible**.

God is specifically concerned with our <u>attitude</u> toward <u>people</u>.

VISUALIZE the Judge ... merciful or harsh based on your history
