This actually provides great simplicity and freedom for life because many decisions can simply be referred to THAT DECISION and the right answer is quickly apparent.

The COMMITMENT of Covenant. The marriage vow must be thoroughly and \_\_\_\_\_\_. While God has designed marriage as beneficial (*Gen. 2:18*), he also recognizes singleness as "good" (*1 Cor. 7:1-2*).
