This is my blood of the covenant, which is poured out for many for the forgiveness of sins.

I tell you, I will not drink from this fruit of the vine from now on until that day when I drink it new with you in my Father's kingdom." When they had sung a hymn, they went out to the Mount of Olives.

Sacrament of <u>communion</u> comes from the <u>Passover meal</u>.

Therefore, it is saturated in **tradition** and **meaning**.

Passover Seder

- <u>Seder</u> meaning order
- Meal that retells the Exodus Story (Exodus 12 + 13)
- A full meal, 4 special cups of wine, a game, washings, story telling, ceremonial elements displayed on the table.



2 specific elements

- Afikomen bread used during a game and a dessert after the meal.
- 2. <u>Cup of Redemption</u> 3rd cup after the meal

Matthew 26:26-30

Jesus said "Do this in Remembrance of Me" (1 Corinthians 11:23-29)

1 Corinthians. 11:23-29

For I received from the Lord what I also delivered to you, that the Lord Jesus on the night when he was betrayed took bread, and when he had given thanks, he broke it, and said, "This is my body, which is for you. Do this in remembrance of me." In the same way also he took the cup, after supper, saying, "This cup is the new covenant in my blood. Do this, as often as you dri nk it, in remembrance of me." For as often as you eat this bread and drink the cup, you proclaim the Lord's death until he comes. Whoever, therefore, eats the bread or drinks the cup of the Lord in an unworthy manner will be guilty concerning the body and blood of the Lord. Let a person examine himself, then, and so eat of the bread and drink of the cup. For anyone who eats and drinks without discerning the body eats and drinks judgment on himself.

Passover is to <u>Remember</u> (old Covenant) how God <u>delivered</u> the Israelites out of Egypt.

Jesus transfers that <u>remembrance</u> to His <u>sacrifice</u> (New Covenant).

Remember = <u>examining yourself</u> – eat in a worthy manner.
