Joseph

What do we know about Joseph? _____ (*Mt. 1:18-19, 13:55*)

Joseph believed Mary had been unfaithful to him (no other conclusion seemed possible!) He could see no way out except to part ways with her. But he was determined to do this in the way that brought the least possible hurt, attention, or condemnation upon her.

*True love combines ______ and _____... an appreciation of the person's <u>divine</u> value and <u>human</u> dignity. It is committed to

even while it is committed to______. (1 Cor. 13:6-7)

Joseph acted as a father to Jesus... so well that he was often assumed to be his biological father (*Mt. 13:35, Lk. 3:23, Jn. 1:45*).

* True love includes that which is not its own. ______ its own self, dreams, accomplishments or biological family, love recognize ______ and ______ outside of itself. It is open minded! It seeks to supply

leadership

or share the load simply because that is needed. To stabilize a perilous situation, Joseph offered himself. Adoption, fostering, handicapped care, blended families, etc. are examples of this triumph of love over selfishness or inconvenience. Authentic love is _____ by messy conditions. (Mt. 7:32-36)

The miracle happened to Mary. She was "highly favored by God" and "blessed among women" and "the mother of my Lord" (*Lk. 2:28, 42-43*). Joseph did not receive such glory or distinction. He drew the straw of "supporting" this woman that he loved. He was present at the birth (*Lk. 2:5-7, 16*). He was expected to abandon his world in order to protect her child (*Mt. 2:13*). He taught Jesus a trade (*Mt. 13:35 cf. Mark 6:3*), but Jesus never supported Joseph financially.

* True love is not ______ or _____. Joseph was content to marvel at Jesus and play second fiddle to Mary (Lk. 2:33-34). He did not ______ for attention or acclaim. Love ______ rather than competes. (Rom. 12:9-10, 15, 1 Cor. 13:4-5)
