Joseph

What do we know about Joseph? NOT MUCH

√ carpenter (Mt. 13:55)

√ "righteous" (Mt. 1:19)

However hurt/angry Joseph was toward Mary, he wanted to let her down gently (Mt. 18:19)

TRUE love combines <u>sacredness</u> and <u>sympathy</u>... appreciates <u>divine</u> value and <u>human</u> dignity.

It is committed to <u>protection</u>, even while it is committed to <u>punishment</u>.

Love does not DELIGHT in evil, but rejoices with the truth. It always protects, always trusts, always hopes, always perseveres. (1 Cor. 13:6-7)

Joseph > father > Jesus

- Jerusalem for purification (Lk. 2:22)
- Egypt to escape Herod (Mt. 2:13-15)
- Jerusalem (every year) > Passover (Lk. 2:41)
- provided a stable home in Nazareth (Mt. 2:19-23, Lk. 2:39-40)
- assumed to be biological father of Jesus (Mt. 13:55, Lk. 3-23, Jn. 1:45)

Beyond its own self, dreams, accomplishment, or biological family, TRUE love recognizes <u>need</u> and <u>hope</u> outside of itself. It is open minded!

Authentic love is <u>not troubled</u> by messy conditions!

The MIRACLE happened to Mary.

Joseph drew the straw of "supporting" this woman that he loved.

TRUE love is not jealous or dominating.

Joseph did not ever <u>compete</u> with Mary for attention or acclaim.

*Love <u>rejoices</u> [in the blessing of the beloved] rather than competes.

Love is patient and kind. It does not ENVY; it does not boost; it is not proud. It is not rude, or SELF SEEKING, or easily angered. It keeps no record of wrongs.

(1 Cor. 13:4-5)

Love must be sincere... devoted to the other... honor one another above yourselves. REJOICE with those who REJOICE; weep with those who weep.
