Galatians 6:1-2

*We occasionally get caught _____ sin. We continually get caught ______ sin.

Caught by sin because of:

1. _____ (Romans 8:3)

- our spiritual ______ is practically nonexistent
- our "flesh" feeds us ______ about God so that we resist him
- our "flesh jams God's frequency creating ______ against his voice

2. _____ (James 1:14-15) The forbidden fruit in Eden looked "pleasing" and "desirable" (Gen. 3:6). This appeal becomes the temptation/trap by which <u>sin</u> catches us.

Matthew 14:22-32

- √ circumstance/storm > caught/struggle > fear hopelessness
 *(profound picture of being caught by sin!)
- $\sqrt{\text{circumstance/Jesus!} > \text{love/hope} > \text{invitation/freedom}}$
- $\sqrt{\text{effort/escape!} > \text{failure/fear} > \text{cry/hand!}}$

No different than someone caught by sin, Peter was failing and flailing until he cried out and reached out ... he was CAUGHT by CHRIST (vs. 31)
