# THE TRAJECTORY Romans 5:1-11

### Order/Events in <u>SPIRITUAL TRANSFORMATION</u> Faith > Justification > Peace > Grace > Hope

FAITH – trigger

JUSTIFICATION – transaction

PEACE – tranquility

GRACE – triumph

HOPE - trajectory

#### **THEOLOGY**

## (vs. 9) By his blood ... *JUSTIFIED*\*legal term considered <u>not guilty</u>

#### **POSSIBILITIES**

- ✓ No charge ever brought
- ✓ Charged but <u>exonerated</u>
- ✓ Charged/Convicted/Penalized/Paid/Finished

(vs. 10) By his death ... *RECONCILED* \*relational term Friendship/fellowship <u>restored</u>

#### **POSSIBILITIES**

- ✓ Removal of the <u>cause</u> of disagreement
- ✓ Decision to <u>overlook</u> the <u>cause</u> of disagreement

(vs. 10) By his life ... SAVED

\*agricultural term <u>prepared/preserved</u>
for market or table

SAVED = no doubt or uncertainty about facing God's <u>final judgement</u>

POINT: If God can accomplish the staggering task of changing the status of a sinner (wrath > grace), he can certainly accomplish the remainder of the process of taking a saint to heaven (grace > glory)

#### ENEMY > FRIEND is <u>more difficult</u> than FRIEND > COMPANION

We rejoice in the hope of the glory of God. Not only so, but we also rejoice in our sufferings, because we know that suffering produces patience [perseverance], patience, character [maturity]; and character, hope. And hope does not disappoint us because ... (Romans 5:3-5)



**SUFFERING** ... chafed/squeezed i.e. pain, pressure, irritation!

PATIENCE ... <u>acceptance</u> of what you <u>have to</u> "remain under"

\*A nail exemplifies patience ...
The harder you hit it the deeper you drive it

## MATURITY [CHARACTER] ... passing a test for quality or approval

HOPE ... confidence that there is a <u>purpose</u> for this suffering AND a <u>power</u> to bring me out of it

## **SATISFACTION** [no disappointment] ... seeing something **positive** in the experience
