

LIVING BREAD FROM HEAVEN

(John 6:41-59)

Jesus used the simple, daily routine of <u>eating food</u> to communicate profound spiritual truth.

- Food:
 Useless unless ______ (Heb. 4:2)

 Interest prompted only ______ (Mt. 5:6, 9:12)

 Appropriation only by ______ (1 Cor. 6:17, Eph. 3:17)

 _______ (Ps. 49:7, Is. 55:7)
 - Consumption produces ______ (*Ps. 63:2-5, Mt. 4:4, Jn. 4:14*)

"This bread is my flesh that I will give for the life of the world... unless you eat this flesh... you have no life in you." (6:51,53) The death of Jesus was literal, actual, and specific. This sentence is a direct metaphor calling flesh bread. ______ food but not ______ is the equivalent to knowing truth (intellectually) but doing nothing about it. Useless to man and unacceptable to God. (cf. LK. 12:47)

<u>Transubstantiation</u> – literal presence of Christ in bread/wine (R. Catholic doctrine)

* This teaching of Jesus *(Jn. 6)* was much ______ than his "last supper," therefore; he could not have been referring to "Communion."

* <u>All</u> of the "Communion" passages in the NT use a ______ (body vs. <u>flesh</u>).

* "Whoever eats my flesh has eternal life" *(6:54)*. If this was a reference to "Communion" then eternal life could be ______ by partaking. Yet Scripture clearly teaches that Communion is only for believers *(1 Cor. 11:27-32)* and salvation is by faith alone. *(Eph. 2:8-9)*

So, this teaching (Jn. 6) cannot simply refer to "Communion" but to the reality of embracing/______ or trusting/_____ Christ as our SATISFACTION (bread) and SUBSTITUTION (blood).
