

When the Hard Thing is the Right Thing

ASA... King of Judah... 875 B.C.

During his reign Judah faced both physical danger and spiritual evil.

*Sometimes it is easier facing the enemy on the field of battle than facing the idols at home.

- When Judah was invaded, ASA responded with prayer and battle. For a king this was expected... patriotic... loyal leadership. Easy! (14:6-15)
- Upon returning home, ASA was confronted by a dude named Azariah who said, "What you have done is wonderful. But we have a greater enemy. These idols among us will destroy us as surely as a hostile army. God is with you, Asa. Do something!" (15:1-7) Asa knew that Azariah was right. This was HARD!

1.	God promises to bless, never between easy or difficult obedience. (Jer. 7:21-23, Mt. 28:20, Jn. 14:15, 1 Jn. 3:24)
2.	To ignore that which you do not appreciate or agree with is "easy." Confrontation of such things is never easy but is often right. COURAGE to and wisdom to confront are available from the Lord! (Acts 5:29, Rom, 8:31-33, Jm. 1:5-6)
	Remaining in a rut when God has given you a different dream or calling is easy. Familiarity. Benefits. Expectations, etc. If your current condition does not match God's, make a change! God will give you COURAGE to
	his (Mt. 4:18-20, Rom. 8:28, Eph. 4:1, 11 Peter 1:10-11)

Courage is not the absence of fear, but rather the assessment that something else is more important than fear! F.D.R.
