

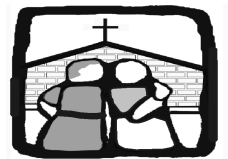

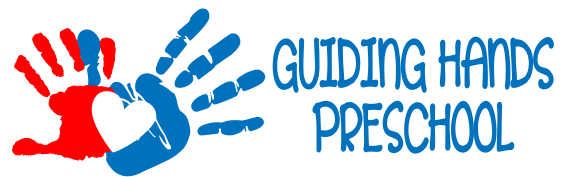

When I am Walking with God

(Psalm 91)

Psalm 91 details God's amazing protection and care and deliverance.
When we are walking in God's purpose and keeping a close relationship with him, we do not need to worry about any danger or design against us!

Notice these **conditions**:

- √ I "dwell" in the shelter of God (1,9)
- √ I trust in God (2)
- √ I love God and acknowledge him (14)
- √ I pray ("call upon God") (15)

(10 - 13) • **protection from danger**

I live unafraid of _____ (sometimes not even knowing _____ about them)!

(14 - 15) • **deliverance out of danger**

All things that do happen will be _____ in their _____ so that they will not _____ me. Trouble or injury may happen, but God's _____ hand will spare my life. I am unafraid of _____ because God "will be with me in trouble."

We have to be more brave than we think we can be, because God is constantly calling us to be more than we are!
