

Daniel 1... FOOD forbidden by God "resolved not <u>defile</u> himself," i.e. not a matter of custom or culture.

STRATEGY

Request

• Second request ("I'm serious here!")

COURAGE

Proposal of a test

Absolute <u>trust</u> in God

SUCCESS!

Commitment to God AND service to King remained intact!

God BLESSED his courage to sacrifice career rather than surrender character!

Daniel 3... worship of image/idol No redefinition, shift, wiggle, or compromise possible here!

STRATEGY

• **Ignore** the expectation, see what happens... accept the consequences

COURAGE

• Willingness to <u>die</u>

Absolute <u>trust</u> in God

SUCCESS!

Miraculous preservation of <u>life</u> and increase of <u>influence</u>!

This courage was not heroism or theatrics. It was simply an expression of their spiritual **conviction**!

Their courage did not fail because it was based on everything they **believed** and **valued**!

Courage is not simply ANOTHER VIRTUE but is the expression of <u>any</u> virtue when it reaches its testing point.
