



RIDE ON KING JESUS

(Matthew 21)

* Religions (ancient and modern) vs. Jewish / Christian Only the Jewish / Christian Scriptures give prophetic details of a coming Messiah that would be God's (Psalm 110) and through (Isaiah 53) would prove himself to be God's (Isaiah 62). • a (strong) on a (weak) proclaiming (peace) Zach. 9:9-10 (*victory = changed hearts rather than slaughtered forces)
 10 (*victory = changed hearts rather than slaughtered forces) a (place) of (intimacy with God) for nations (anyone) Is. 56:3-8 (*love = wanting the adversaries and the misfits to find God's salvation) the (surprise!) of (non-technical) exalting God, by God's own (intention) Psalm 8:2. (* wisdom = not allowing "intelligence" to interfere with acknowledging God)
* The Old Testament quotations Jesus LEGITIMIZE the Old Testament quotations Jesus! SAVIOR. KING. Limo donkey. Bodyguards none. Army parents and children. Weapons palm fronds. He didn't look much like a king that day. But that was his point. Not trying to look like an earthly king but telegraphing a message, "This is the kind of King I am."
◆The crowds but did not truly •The Jewish leaders but they did not •The decision of what to and about Jesus was put to everyone
in Jesus? Millions are interested but have no living relationship with him. "There is a time to think and a time to decide." in Jesus? Millions who "believe in" Jesus do not follow what they believe. "Belief without bravery leads only to a spiritual cul de sac." Jesus? This leads to the cross the loss of pride, the acknowledgment of sin, the transfer of guilt, the freedom of forgiveness, and the gift of [eternal] life.

*Jesus chose a colt that no one had ever ridden on because no one had ever gone where he was going ... to the grave and through the grave!
