# PRIDE

**3:7-8** "Wise in his own eyes" is an ancient way of saying "*know it all*" or "*smart aleck*". It is not discouraging education or disparaging intellect.  
Point: HUMBLY LISTEN and CONSIDER the \_\_\_\_\_ of God and the \_\_\_\_\_ of other people. This would be true "wisdom".

**6:1-5** Stubbornness that is UNWILLING to \_\_\_\_\_ wrong or \_\_\_\_\_ posture is simply pride. This holds me in bondage and \_\_\_\_\_ my possibilities.

**9:7-9** An unwillingness to RECEIVE criticism or a "*same to you*" RESPONSE indicates pride that will destroy every \_\_\_\_\_ and cost many \_\_\_\_\_ and \_\_\_\_\_ that would have blessed my life.

**16:5** The ROOT of all pride (fallen nature) is an UNWILLINGNESS to \_\_\_\_\_ God and DETERMINATION to be the god of my own life. This \_\_\_\_\_ to the Creator will not stand.

**16:18** More than any genetic, financial, or circumstantial disadvantage, pride \_\_\_\_\_ for failure! Power, position, not intelligence \_\_\_\_\_ me from the destructive nature of pride. Eventually it will do its damage.

## Expressions of Pride

ATTENTION - constantly seeking/demanding **(25:27)**

INATTENTION - no real interest in others; disdain **(14:20)**

MOCKING - haughtiness regarding mistakes/misfortunes of others

**(3:34)**

APOLOGY - refusal to descend to such "humiliation" **(28:13)**

CRITICISM - freely given (proving your superiority **(19:11)**)

CRITICISM - received only with anger and resentment **(13:10)**

REVENGE - any other response considered a weakness **(29:11)**
