(Romans 7:7-25)

- 1. I was happy with my life...Unaware of sin... Ignorance was bliss.
- 2. God's LAW showed up. "Do not covet!"
- 3. Suddenly I felt all sorts of covetous desires!
- 4. I realized I was a sinner! My sin was rebelling against God's expectation (law)!
- 5. Since the law represented expectation and penalty, I realized I was doomed.
- 6. But I said, "I like God's law. It is right. I will obey."
- 7. However, when I had opportunity to obey, I disobeyed!
- 8. The law (meant to show me how to live) now condemned me.
- 9. Sin had a greater hold than I realized. It had deceived me!
- 10. God's LAW pointed this out to me, how utterly EVIL and TRAGIC sin really is.
- 11. I said, "I'll take charge of sin! Deep down, I truly delight in God's law."
- 12. But sin successfully fights back. I discover that I am a SLAVE to sin.
- 13. Conclusion: Every time I seek to follow God's law, my "flesh" opposes me!
- 14. I am a walking battlefield, my spiritual/fleshly nature in perpetual war.
- 15. I am wretched. I acknowledge this. I humbly hope for help (rescue).
- 16. WHO? Jesus Christ our Lord! Thanks be to God!
