### FEAR OF GOD

Fear is a complex word whose meaning is determined by the context in which it is used. In Old Testament usage (300+) its most common object is GOD. Amazingly, this word can be both positive and negative.

terror... sheer \_\_\_\_\_, running, hiding, lying, etc. (translated as "afraid")

• awe... great \_\_\_\_\_, utterly impressed (translates as "reverence" or "worship")

\* Jonah 1:15 (afraid) 1:10 (terrified) 1:16 (awestruck) <u>same</u> word expresses <u>different</u> emotions because the sea "raged" and then "grew calm."

For a multitude of reasons, a thinking, rational person MUST FEAR GOD! Only a \_\_\_\_\_\_ would be \_\_\_\_\_\_ of God's power to judge and punish (*Mt. 10:28, 11 Cor. 5:11*). Yet the \_\_\_\_\_\_ of the Bible is not fright but \_\_\_\_\_\_. "What does the Lord your God ask of you but to FEAR him, to WALK in his ways, to LOVE him, to SERVE him with all your heart and soul, and to OBSERVE his commands and decrees that I am giving you today for your own good?" (*Deut. 10:12-13*)

#### LOVE/FEAR PARADOX

How can you love someone of whom you are terrified? Why would you be afraid of someone who loves you? 1. We are afraid of God because he can destroy us. Jesus \_\_\_\_\_\_\_ of that fear (Rom. 5:1, 8:1) 2. We are intimidated by God because he is overwhelmingly impressive. This is the positive kind of fearfulness. We are \_\_\_\_\_\_\_ to love him! We feel compelled to love him. (Rom. 11:33-36) 3. We respect God because of his superiority... not \_\_\_\_\_\_ but \_\_\_\_\_! This respect is to our credit. It is the beginning of \_\_\_\_\_\_ (Prov. 9:10) 4. So the positive fear (awe) leads to love (admiration) and the love \_\_\_\_\_\_ any

fear (alarm). This leads to increasing confidence. (1 Jn. 4:17-18) FEAR (respect/regard) > PERFECT LOVE < FEAR (panic/alarm)
