# I CANNOT DO THIS!

(Matthew 3)

John the Baptist had a short lived, powerful, provocative life. His fiery rhetoric stirred people up! His life and preaching had a narrow focus.
MISSION: Prepare people an of Jesus.
METHOD: Confrontational, "repentance" (Lk. 3:3, 7-9)  APPEARANCE: Rough and simple; garb. (Mk. 1:6)  LOCATION: Jordan river just north of the dead sea (Judea). (Lk. 3:3, Mk. 1:5)  One day (unexpectedly) Jesus showed up, coming all the way from the northern territory of Galilee. (Mt. 3:5, 13)
HIGH DRAMA "Baptize me also, John."  "No way! Unthinkable! If anything, you must baptize me. (3:13-14)
Reply of Jesus: (3:15) This act of baptism was God's righteous plan by which Jesus IDENTIFIED with man and man's sin. He could not for them unless he fully their condition which baptism  Isaiah 53:12 - numbered with the transgressors.  11 Cor. 5:21 - made him who knew no sin to be sin on our behalf.
Consider John's reluctance, not simply theological, but human. He did not feel capable for this task that came unexpectedly upon him. He felt overwhelmed and strenuously objected. "I cannot do this."
In the reply of Jesus (apart from theology) is God's answer to those who do not enjoy their responsibility or feel ineffective for their assigned role.
