REVERSAL Vashti > Esther Haman > Mordecai • Kill/plunder Jews (3:13) > Kill/plunder Jewish enemies (8:11) RESTRAINT The Jews struck down enemies, but refused to plunder or (9:5-10, 16). Across the provinces, 75,000 enemies steal. were taken out, but no assets were taken. (9:16) How did they know who to kill? Fighting defensively, they killed only those attacking them. And they were attacked,

per Xerxes' order "Annihilate the Jews on 12/13." (3:13-14)

Throughout this horrific situation, the Jews did not seek revenge or retaliation. Legally, they were allowed to loot, but they said, "No." Though their enemies had intended to steal their property, they did not reply in kind. In this they were aware of God's between (court ordered) punishment for domestic crime ("eye for eye"), (Ex. 21:22-25, Lev. 24:20) and conduct in war with an enemy ("vengeance belongs to God." (Deut. 32:35, Rom. 12:17-21)
