Several different Sunday School classes for children, teens, and adults are offered: 9:50 am-10:35 am. Still other seed fell on GOOD soil, where it produced a crop... many times what was sown.

The GOOD soil is the man who hears the word and understands it. He produces a crop... (Mt. 13:8, 23)

Goodness inherently contains benefits and value.

Goodness <u>improves</u> conditions or provides <u>possibility</u> for future improvement.

Goodness <u>provides</u> favor, love, blessings, unity, prosperity, generosity, confidence, ETC.

Goodness seeks <u>positive</u> outcomes, <u>peaceful</u> relationships, and <u>practical</u> achievements.

GOD. Moral <u>perfection</u> AND <u>mercy</u> toward humans (who are <u>not</u> perfect).

WORKS of God. To us, they reveal <u>wisdom</u> and <u>power</u> beyond our comprehension!

GIFTS of God. Both material **creation** and human **relation**, benefit our existence.

Even you who are evil know how to give GOOD gifts to your children. Well, duh! Don't you think God will give GOOD gifts to those who ask him? (Mt. 7:11, paraphrased!)

Every GOOD and perfect gift comes down from above, from the Father... (Jm. 1:17)

Apart from you, O Lord, I have <u>nothing</u> GOOD! (Ps. 16:2)

But Jesus has come as the high priest of the GOOD things that are <u>already here!</u> (Heb. 9:11)

GOD is the norm, standard, arbiter, and judge of goodness.

Why do you call me good? There is only one who is good. That is God. (Mt. 10:18)

Therefore, [morally] there is a difference between <u>nice</u> and <u>good</u>. People are GOOD only so far as they follow the purpose and accept the will of God.

Woe to those who call evil good and good evil, who put darkness for light and light for darkness. (Is. 5:20)

Micah 6:8 He has shown you, O man, what is GOOD. And what does the Lord God require of you? To show **justice**, to love **mercy**, and to walk in **humility** with your Lord.

Mordecai was highly regarded? Why? (Esther 10)

 WORKED for good of the people (tob... advantage, opportunity

 SPOKE UP for the WELFARE (<u>shalom</u>... well being) of the Jewish [disadvantaged] people. 1. Work <u>for</u> good presupposes a heart <u>of</u> goodness.

But the seed on good soil stands for someone with a noble and good heart who hears the work, retains it, and perseveres until they produce a harvest. (Luke 8:15)

2. A heart of goodness is vigilant to **recognize** and **avoid** evil.

A good tree cannot bear bad fruit... (Mt. 7:15)

Good works cannot **earn** salvation. HOWEVER...

Saved people are <u>equipped</u> and <u>expected</u> to do GOOD WORKS!

You are God's craftsmanship, created in Christ, to do good works (which God has already prepared for you to do!) (Eph. 2:10)

And God is able to make all grace abound to you so that in all times and places having all that you need, you will abound in every GOOD WORK!

(11 Cor. 9:8)

Let your light so shine in the presence of men that they will see your GOOD WORKS and glorify your Father in heaven! (Mt. 5:16)

... a people that are his own, <u>eager</u> to do GOOD WORKS... <u>devoted</u> to doing good works. (*Titus 2, 3*)

[having to do with leadership and governing]. For he is God's servant to DO YOU GOOD! (Rom. 13:4)
