## **WALKING WITH JESUS**

<b>Easter Sunday afternoon</b> . Two folks walked from Jerusalem to Emmaus. Jesus joined them (unrecognized). They were sad, disappointed, and confused. "We had hoped but" Jesus helped them to understand events and that God had a
Emmaus evening. Jesus was willing to keep going and did not press or pressure them. They him to stay. At the meal they and him! He vanished! They were so pumped up, they immediately returned to Jerusalem (7 miles!) to tell folks there.
They recognized him because they:  √ and facts from the Bible  (prophecies/explanations)  √ for conversation and contemplation.  Christ's rebuke for them was not for what they <u>did</u> believe, but that they did not believe (prophecies regarding suffering/death). Either they did not understand the prophecies or
did not believe them entirely, because such predictions were there.
Jacob (Num. 24:17) > Judah (Gen. 49:10) > Jesse (Is 11:1) > David (Jer. 23:5) [Roman] empire (Dan. 2:29-45) > Bethlehem (Micah 5:2) > "messenger" (Is. 40-3, Mal. 3:1) Anointed One (Dan. 9:25) > Galilee (Is. 9:1) > Jerusalem/donkey (Zech. 9:9) Anointed One "cut off" (Dan 9:26, Is. 53:7-9) > Resurrection (Ps. 16:10, Is. 53:11) Substitution/Atonement (Is. 3:5, 11-12)
Jesus came and walked with these folks in their time of grief and confusion. Will he do any less or differently for us? No. In our most painful, baffling, or difficult times, his is with us on the road we walk.  (Heb. 13:4-6, 8)
