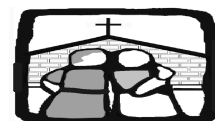

The same story is recorded by Mark and John. Lazarus lived in Bethany, but the meal was served at Simon's house, Lazarus being present.

Jesus: "Whenever the gospel story is told, this story will [should] also be told"... i.e. What she has done should be _____ what I have done.

WHY THIS WASTE? *Too much for too little

Judas (symbolizing an unbelieving world). Time service, money, etc., given to God's kingdom is no measure of _____, but rather of _____. Delusion. Incompetence.

Others (believers who wish only to gain rather than give). Success is measured by _____ and _____ rather than affection, worship, or submission. Worship money could be "help poor people" money. Misguided. Unwise. Rash.

SIGNIFICANCE: Whatever you do to glorify God, express your loyalty, or obey the vision he has given you is NEVER WASTED! Folks may not understand or approve. Folks may laugh at your cluelessness or scold your foolishness. Pay no attention! Mary poured out her perfume unto Jesus, then Jesus "poured out his life unto death" (*Is. 53:12*). When we give ourselves to God without reservation, this pleases God. How could such a life (whatever the circumstance) be wasted?
