

FORGIVENESS

Matthew	6:12.	14-15

When I ask God to forgive me, I am IMPLYING that I
forgiveness and therefore would forgiveness to anyone
when it is requested of me.
• God's forgiveness is based upon the <u>sincerity</u> of our request to him. That
sincerity is proven or disproven by my to
my forgiveness.
God understands and sympathizes with the <u>difficulty</u>
(emotions) of forgiveness. He is not put off by the human
disgust/anger at the perpetrator of the offense. He weighs
my sincerity, effort, desire, and determination to forgive.
My Question: Have I overcome/eliminated all
?
God's Question: Do they to forgive? Do they that outcome?
THE LOGIC OF FORGIVENESS
a. There is no logic by which a willful trespass to be ignored or disregarded
b. There is great logic in saying, "Since God extends forgiveness me, then he would
expect
to extend forgiveness me." <i>(Eph. 4:32, Col. 3:13, Mt. 18:21-35)</i>
<u>Matthew 18:18</u>
In the context of church discipline (18:15-17), Jesus said, "When someone has met the conditions of
forgiveness [confession - 1 Jn. 1-9] [repentance - Lk. 24:47], you have the (authority) to
declare God's forgiveness to them and the to show them forgiveness yourself [turned loose in heaven > turned loose on earth"]. This statement is not saying that God is obligated to follow my
lead ("bind or loose"), but exactly the opposite!
WHAT DOES IT MEAN TO FORSIVE SOMEONES
WHAT DOES IT MEAN TO FORGIVE SOMEONE?
1. Turn them loose from the punishment of wrath or revenge, i.e. refrain from personal
vengeance. the incident
2 or the incident. *This does not mean that penalty or justice should not be pursued. This is God's purpose
for "government" so that "punishment" is transferred from the wronged individual to the
officials
who decide/speak for <u>all</u> the people (Rom. 13:3-4).
