#### Matthew 6... The Lord's prayer

vs. 12 – When I ask God to forgive me, I am IMPLYING that I <u>value</u> forgiveness and therefore would <u>extend</u> forgiveness to anyone when it is requested of me.

vs. 14-15 – God's forgiveness is offered to all but only applied to those who request forgiveness in sincerity. That sincerity is proven or disproven by my response to humans who seek my forgiveness.

# God understands and sympathizes with the DIFFICULTY (emotions) of forgiveness.

He is not put off by my anger/disgust.

 However, he analyzes my desire and effort to actually forgive. MY QUESTION: Have I overcome/eliminated all <u>negative</u> <u>emotions</u>?

GOD'S QUESTION: Do you <u>want</u> to forgive? Do you <u>seek</u> that outcome?

### **LOGIC** of Forgiveness

There is no LOGIC by which a willful trespass <u>deserves</u> to be ignored or disregarded.

Eph. 4:32 "...just as in Christ God forgave you."

Col. 3:13 "...as the Lord forgave you."

There is great logic in saying, "Since God extends forgiveness <u>to</u> me, God would expect to extend forgiveness <u>through</u> me."

Truly I say to you, whatever you BIND on earth will be [lit: will already have been] bound in heaven, and whatever you LOOSE on earth will be loosed in heaven. *Matthew 18:18* 

When someone has met the conditions of forgiveness, you have the <u>right</u> (authority) to declare God's forgiveness to them and the <u>responsibility</u> to show them forgiveness yourself.

## WHAT DOES IT MEAN TO FORGIVE SOMEONE?

1. Turn them loose from the punishment of **my** wrath or revenge.

2. Leave or abandon the incident.

#### **GOAL OF FORGIVENESS?**

To be <u>like God</u> who shows goodness/mercy to unrighteous folks as well as righteous.

To avoid the power of [the perpetrator's] evil **pulling** me **into** its misery.

Do not repay evil for evil... as far as it depends on you, live at peace with everyone... do not take revenge... heap burning coals on his head.. do not be overcome with evil... overcome evil with good (Romans 12:17-21).
