

DISCERNMENT

A: Observation. Prayer

*If you trusted and were deceived, God judges rather than
(1 Cor. 4:5)
If your motives are righteous, how could God, who judges impartially and justly not know this?
This is why Jesus did not retaliate but himself to the Heavenly Father who KNEW his heart (1 Peter 1:17, 2:23).
 Q: How are we to treat/respond to homosexual people? A: No differently than anyone who lives in any ongoing sinful condition. Helpfulness. Warning. Prayer. Humility
<u>Genesis 1:26-27</u> Because God had in mind a <u>task</u> ("rule over"), he engineered a design ("image of God") and created a <u>product</u> (male/female). This was his plan ("let us make let them rule"). Homosexuality, transgenderism, etc. God's <i>plan</i> and the <i>pattern</i> [FAMILY] by which the male/female combination express the fullness of his image.
Therefore, the Bible always describes homosexuality as being to God and to saying that his design was mistaken. It is rebellion against his LAW (design, expectation) (1 Tim. 1:9-10) and perversion of his intention (Rom. 1:26-27).
This is why (while loving the person and knowing that forgiveness and change is possible) we must to support, abet, or encourage it (<i>Eph. 5:3-7</i>). This is one of those issues where the world needs to understand a between those who obey God and those who do not. We cannot honor a culture or custom that denies God's clear and unambiguous will (<i>Acts 4:19 5:29</i>)
