(John 17)

1. world = creation, (5, 6, 11, 13, 18, 24)					
2. world = (non-Christians) as <u>contrasted</u> with believers					
(9, 14, 15, 16,21, 23, 25)					
A. Does Jesus <u>love</u> the unsaved "world" since he was "not praying for them"?					
YES. He came to "all people to give eternal life" (2). Now he sends those who have believed into the world with that message (18). And he DOES pray for the unbelieving world that					
they "may believe" (21).					
* This phrase "(vs. 9) is quite to that "protect/unify them" (11).					
* John 3:16 uses "world" in the sense of #1 above.					
B. Does the phrase "eternal life to those you have given him" (2) indicate that we are predestined to					
heaven or hell prior to birth? (Some are simply lucky, some are doomed.).					
<u>Calvin</u> > YES . God has predestined, elected, chosen certain ones for both destinies.					
TULIP. God's will is					
Arminius > NO. God has willed/provided for everyone to be saved (Acts 10:43,					
1 Tim. 2:3). The chosen/elected are those who respond positively. They are "chosen					
according to God's foreknowledge" (1 Peter 1:2) as contrasted to "chosen according to					
God's preference, bias, or partiality." (prohorizo) does not mean but foreknown, aware, planned (Rom. 8:29). God is omniscient (Is. 41:22-					
23). But it is disingenuous to say that God's knowing something is equivalent to his					
causing it. Man's will is					
The world is described by John's gospel as by Satan (12:31, 16:11)					
and to its Creator and Savior (1:9-11), 7:7). In this prayer, Jesus					
states that his followers:
