


√ Discipline toward <u>self</u>

Reserve **TIME** and **TALK** for God (5-6)

I will not <u>rush</u> into decisions... consideration, assessment, prayer

I will not <u>avoid</u> decisions out of <u>fear</u>, but upon acknowledging God, I will <u>trust</u> and <u>act</u>.

√ Confidence in God

√ Humility toward <u>self</u>

PAY back and INVEST forward (9-10).

I will not be a person that <u>receives</u> without giving or <u>benefits</u> without contributing.

I will **give** unto the **Lord** the "first portion" of **money** and trust Him to "fill my barns."

LIFE PRINCIPLE Priority determines procedure determines product
